## **ORDINANCE NO. 235**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW MARKET, IOWA 51646, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO TRUCK PARKING LIMITED

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of New Market, Iowa:

**SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED**, The Code of Ordinances of the City of New Market, Iowa, 51646, is amended by modifying location of exception to have trucks parked at as follows:

**69.09 TRUCK PARKING LIMITED.** No person shall park a motor truck, semi-trailer, or other motor vehicle with trailer attached in violation of the following regulations. The provisions of this section do not apply to pickup, light delivery or panel delivery trucks.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.236[1])

1. No person shall park any truck over 40 feet in length, weighing five (5) / tons or more, loaded or empty, within the City limits except in the following location(s):

A. On south side of West 1<sup>st</sup> Street between signs, not to block access west to dead end.

Trucks shall be parked in these locations for a maximum of seventy-two (72) hours.

- 2. Noise. No such vehicle shall be left standing or parked upon any street, alley public or private parking lot, or drive of any service station with the engine, auxiliary engine, air compressor, refrigerating equipment or other device in operation giving off audible sounds excepting only the drive of a service station when actually being serviced, and then in no event for more than thirty (30) minutes.
- 3. Livestock. No such vehicle containing livestock shall be parked on any street, alley or highway for a period of time of more than thirty (30) minutes.
- 4. Empty Livestock Trailers. Empty livestock trailers parked within the City limits must be washed and clean of any animal waste or garbage debris.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
